Is access to the Bulgarian insolvency register free of charge?

Access to the Bulgarian insolvency register is free of charge.

How can I search the Bulgarian insolvency register?

You can search for a [receiver](#) (*синдик*) by name on the website.

How to carry out a search by sale

The [sales bulletin](#) (*бюлетин по продажбите*) can be found on the website of the Ministry of the Economy.

The following criteria can be used to search:

- Case number, year, court, unique identification code (*ЕИК*) of debtor (*длъжник*), name of debtor, name of receiver, city, type of sale, date.
- Pending sales and past sales are included.

History of the Bulgarian insolvency register

AISTN (*АИСТН*) was set up by the Ministry of Justice to comply with the requirements of the amendments to the Commercial Act (*Търговски закон*).
