- some elements have ARIA attributes with invalid values,
- some aria-hidden elements contain focusable elements,
- some ARIA buttons, links and menu items do not have an accessible name,
- some pages have elements with insufficient colour contrast,
- some form elements do not have labels,
- some links have indiscernible text,
- some interactive controls are nested,
- some active elements are not using unique id attributes,
- some lists have an incorrect structure,
- some document titles are missing text alternatives.
