## My e-Justice space

Romania

In most of the cases, the only facilitation Romanian public administration authorities provide is to download the relevant templates to request a service, but the procedure must be finalised in person. The responsible authority may be at centralized, district or local level. However, there are some services such as for participating in judicial auctions or accessing the services of the National Trade Registry Office which are fully online.

For Romanian citizens living abroad, most of the services can be requested online through the [econsulate](#) portal. Following registration in the portal, it is possible to request the issuance of several documents and certificates such as birth, death, a person being alive, Romanian citizenship etc., but also ID documents such as the Romanian Passport and the first Romanian ID card. These services are in most of the cases free of charge, only in some cases such as passport issuance a fee is applied.

### Possibility to lodge an application for legal aid

It is not possible to lodge an application for legal aid online in Romania.

### Compensation

No public body provides online services related to compensation in Romania.

### Initiation of a civil case online

It is not possible to initiate a civil case online in Romania. However, the claim can be lodged by e-mail.

### Electronic service of judicial documents

No public body provides online services related to the electronic service of judicial documents in Romania.

## Participation in judicial auctions

Purpose and scope: Romanian citizens have the possibility to participate in judicial auctions online through the [ANABI platform](#), pertaining to the [Agenția Națională de Administrare a Bunurilor Indisponibilizate](#)

Competent authority: [Agenția Națională de Administrare a Bunurilor Indisponibilizate](#) under the Romanian Ministry of Justice

Conditions of access:

- Eligibility requirements: Natural and Juridical persons from Romania and abroad can request access to the ANABI Platform.
- Identification and authentication requirements: As part of the registration process, ANABI employees verify the data and information submitted by applicants. If these data are complete, the applicants will be assigned a unique identification code and password based on their identification data, which will be sent to them by e-mail.
- Documents to be provided:
  - Identification documents:  
Scenario 1: In the case of a natural person bidder: copy/scan of identity card/registration document, etc. Foreign individuals should attach copy/scan of identity card, passport, tax identification number, etc.;
  - Scenario 2: In the case of a legal entity bidder: copy/scan of the single certificate of registration as well as the extract from the Trade Register (RECOM extract). Foreign legal entities must attach the registration document translated into Romanian, as well as the Extract from the Register of the competent authority showing the representatives of the legal entity, translated into Romanian;
  - Bank statement of the bidder;
  - Proof of payment by the bidder of the guarantee for the participation, representing 10% of the starting price of the tender (possible via internet banking service).

## Company formation and access to information on companies

Purpose and scope: Romanian citizens and juridical persons in Romania can submit the necessary documentation to finalize company registration online, as well as access information on companies through the National Trade Registry Office ([Oficiul National al Registrului Comertului](#) under the Romanian Ministry of Justice) portal ONRC.

Competent authority: National Trade Registry Office ([Oficiul National al Registrului Comertului](#) under the Romanian Ministry of Justice)

Conditions of access:

- Eligibility requirements: Natural and Juridical persons operating in Romania can request access to the ONRC portal
- Identification and authentication requirements: The ONRC online portal provides services accessible to any Natural or Juridical person who has an account in the portal.
- Documents to be provided: The information is provided on <https://www.onrc.ro/index.php/ro/>, in the sections: Incorporations, Amendments, Dissolution/Liquidations/Strikes off, Information.

Legal effects of electronic document: Full legal effects

Possibility to complete the procedure fully online: Yes

Cost: After creating an account on the ONRC portal, the user can access services either for free or for a fee, depending on the type of service
