

Specialised courts - Croatia

The specialised courts are commercial courts and administrative courts as court of first instance, and the High Misdemeanour Court of the Republic of Croatia, the High Commercial Court of the Republic of Croatia and the Supreme Administrative Court of the Republic of Croatia shall rule on the courts of second instance.

In relation to the area of administration of justice:

Commercial courts

Nine commercial courts (Zagreb, Split, Rijeka, Osijek, Bjelovar, Varaždin, Zadar, Pazin, Dubrovnik) were established in the Republic of Croatia:

which:

1. decide in contentious and non-contentious matters where this is required by a special law,
2. Act and conduct court registers;
3. they shall decide on proposals relating to the establishment, operation and termination of the company,
4. they shall decide on proposals to open insolvency proceedings and pursue pre-insolvency and insolvency proceedings;
5. they decide on the entries in the register of ships and yachts in the matters placed under the jurisdiction of the Commercial Court, limiting the liability of the shipping company, and limiting the liability of the shipping company, by complaints against the final distributed basis for the winding up of a common haven, if the law for a particular type of law does not provide otherwise;
6. conduct a procedure for recognition of foreign judgments, as well as arbitration awards in commercial disputes,
7. they shall provide proof for the procedures otherwise in charge;
8. determine the measures of insurance in the proceedings and the procedures for which they normally have jurisdiction,
9. they shall provide international legal assistance for the taking of evidence in commercial matters,
10. they also perform other tasks specified by law.

Administrative courts

Four administrative courts were identified in the Republic of Croatia, namely in Zagreb, Split, Rijeka and Osijek which:

1. decide on actions against individual decisions of public law authorities,
2. decide on actions against the actions of bodies governed by public law,
3. decide on actions for failure to take individual decisions or actions by a body governed by public law within the time limit laid down by law,
4. decide on actions brought against administrative contracts and the execution of administrative contracts,
5. they shall decide in other law the cases referred to above.

High Misdemeanour Court of the Republic of Croatia

1. decides on ordinary legal remedies against decisions of the municipal courts in misdemeanour cases and decisions of public law bodies operating at first instance infringement proceedings where this is required by a special law,
2. to resolve conflicts of jurisdiction between municipal courts in infringement cases,
3. decides on exceptional legal remedies against final infringement decisions where this is required by a special law,
4. decide on appeals in cases of international judicial cooperation with EU Member States under jurisdiction,
5. supervise the orderly conduct of the work of judges working on infringement cases,
6. perform other tasks specified by law.

High Commercial Court of Croatia

1. rule on appeals brought by commercial courts at first instance,
2. settle the territorial jurisdiction of the commercial courts and decide on the delegation of jurisdiction between the commercial courts,
3. perform other tasks specified by law.

High administrative Court of the Republic of Croatia

1. decide on appeals against judgments of administrative courts and orders against which appeal is sought,
2. decides on the legality of the general acts;
3. decides on the conflict of competence between the administrative courts,
4. to decide in other law cases.
