**Introduction**

The Procedural Regulation governing the implementation of the European Order for Payment Procedure in Cyprus is the 2008 Procedural Regulation on the European Payment Order Procedure (7/2008), which entered into force on 12/6/2008.

**What fees are charged?**

Article 25 of the Rules of Procedure provides that the costs to be paid are not to exceed the costs of ordinary civil proceedings, which apply to the corresponding scale for actions, as referred to in Form H of Annex VIII (see Annex VIII).

**How much will I pay?**

See the answer to question 2 above.

**What if I do not pay court fees in time?**

A prerequisite for the promotion of the European Payment Order application is the payment of court fees.

**How can I pay for court fees?**

The court fees can be paid through the Central Bank of Cyprus.

**What do I do once I have made payment?**

Subsequently, after the Central Bank has established the District Court for the transfer of a transfer with a credit note, the file will be referred to the competent judge ordering the execution of the Order for Payment if the conditions are met.

(D) When the amount required or the value of the claim at issue above EUR 10.000 but not EUR 50.000	94,00
(e) When the amount required or the value of the claim at issue above EUR 50.000 but not EUR 100.000	154,00
Where the amount required or the value of the claim at issue above EUR 100.000 but not EUR 500.000	256,00
(g) Where the amount required or the value of the item in question exceeds EUR 500.000 but not EUR 2.000.000	342,00
(h) When the amount required or the value of the claim at issue this is more than EUR 2.000.000	427,00

It is understood that if after an action has been registered the amount claimed by the claimant is increased, the difference in fees will be paid.

It is understood that if by registering a counterclaim the value of the disputed item is increased, the difference in fees shall be paid by the defendant (cedant).
